It has been estimated that 70% of children have a malocclusion. These children are in your office and therefore you do not have to do any external marketing. Orthodontics is a team game. You must educate your staff and yourself to treat your existing patients. Parents are actively looking for dentists who can treat their children's narrow jaws and crooked teeth at an early age.

Early treatment prevents the need for the extraction of permanent teeth and possibly surgery later on. The parents do not want to wait until the malocclusion gets worse and the cost of orthodontic treatment increases. It is also much easier to convince an 8 year old girl to wear a removable or fixed appliance to correct the problem rather than to treat teenagers later on.
