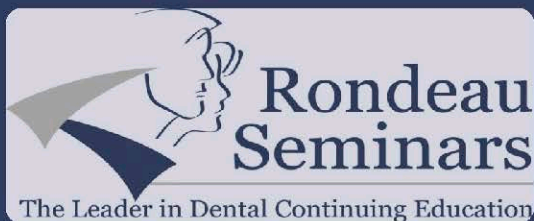

# NEW ORTHODONTIC MASTERY PROGRAM



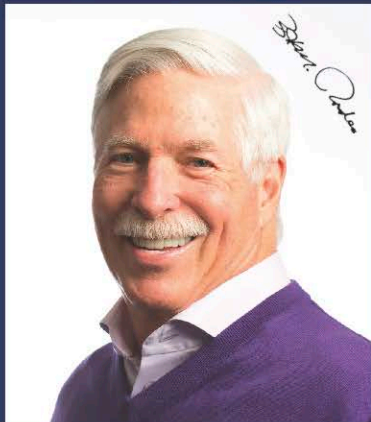

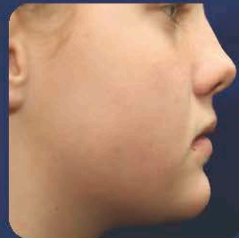

# TMD AND SNORING AND SLEEP APNEA

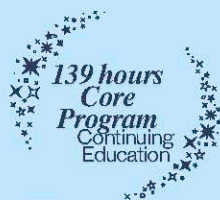

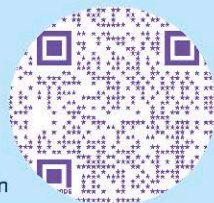

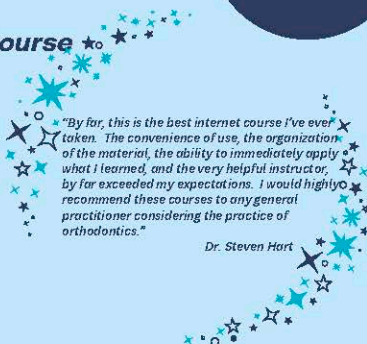
